2. Home Brewed Bitter (label or recipe to be attached)
3. Home Made White Wine – hedgerow or kit (state type on label)
4. Home Made Red Wine – hedgerow or kit (state type on label)
5. Three Shortbread Biscuits (judged on taste and appearance)
6. Plain Sponge or Swiss Roll with Jam Filling (judged on taste and appearance)
7. Savoury Flan in Pastry Case (judged on taste and appearance)
8. Fruit Loaf (judged on taste and appearance)
9. Jar of Lemon Curd (judged on flavour and appearance)
10. Jar of Strawberry Jam (judged on flavour and appearance)
11. Arrangement using Fruit and Foliage (not to exceed 40cm x 40cm x 40cm)
12. Dried Flowers Arrangement (not to exceed 30cm x 30cm x 30cm)
13. Colour Photograph – Subject 'Seascape' (not exceeding A5)
14. Colour Photograph – Subject 'Animals Do The Funniest/Cutest Things'  
(not exceeding A5)
15. Calligraphy – Psalm 23, The Lord is My Shepherd (first verse only)
16. Make a Soft Toy – Suitable for Baby's Pram/Cot (sample of material(s) attached)
17. Cross Stitch Card to Celebrate Queen's Diamond Jubilee (maximum A5 – sample silks attached)
18. Decoupage – Congratulations Card (maximum A5)
19. Pencil Sketch of Blackpool Tower (not to exceed 30cm x 30cm)
20. Watercolour – Subject 'A Bridge' (not to exceed 30cm x 30cm)
21. 6 and under: Draw and Colour Your Favourite Toy
22. 7-9: Any Pattern in Any Medium in the Colours of Red, White and Blue
23. 10-12: An Animal Made From Vegetables
24. Teens: Make a Kite in Any Materials (not exceeding 2' 6")
